

Northland Pines Community Garden (NPCG) Application 2021
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Guidelines for Gracious Gardening

Gardeners must understand and agree to the following rules and responsibilities before receiving garden privileges.

- Garden fees are \$30 per 10'x10' plot **payable by April 1** and also requires 10 hours volunteer time.
Fee includes water, compost, fence, shed, tools, and herbs.
- Gardeners will sign up for volunteer time on Garden Opening Day; list will be posted in the shed.
Examples: weed/water/pick Food Pantry Plots and trees, compost pile, trim along fence, etc.
- Gardeners are responsible for planting, weeding, and clean up of their own garden plots by closing day, which depends on the weather.
- Gardeners are responsible for removing weeds from their plots and surrounding paths, do not put weeds in compost pile. Your weeds and trash should be removed from the garden.
- NPCG is an Organic Garden where **chemical weed killers and pesticides are NOT allowed.**
Look for the **OMRI** (Organic Management Review Institute) Seal on products that are safe.
- Notify the NPCG board if you are no longer able to tend to your plot.
- If you are not harvesting ripe produce, we may request to pick it and donate it to the Vilas County Food Pantry.
- Park car in the parking lot, do not drive up to garden without permission from Northland Pines School.
Pets, smoking, and alcohol are not allowed in the garden or on school grounds.
- Parents or accompanying adults are responsible for children. Please teach your children the garden rules, especially to respect others plots and the water system.
