Distance Learning vs. Hybrid Learning

WHAT?

Hybrid Learning

Hybrid Learning is an option for students to connect to their courses via the internet from home. A hybrid learning plan is developed with the school counselor, parent and student during a formal meeting. A contract outlining the plan, including the parent and student responsibilities is signed by the parent and student. Students with a hybrid learning plan commit to a minimum of 3 weeks.

Temporary Distanced Learning

Temporary Distanced Learning is a short term option for students if they are going to be out of school for a short period of time (home per school policy, home for safety reasons, or ill but are able to participate in class). This option allows students to engage in learning while out of school for a time frame that is less than three weeks.
