Dinosaur Eggs

This is a non-edible recipe

If your family would like to try it, you will need:


1 cup flour

1 cup used & dried coffee grounds

 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup salt

 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup sand

 $\frac{3}{4}$ cup water



All you need to do is:

- 1. Mix all dry ingredients together in a bowl.
- 2. Add the water in small amounts and stir the mixture until it is the consistency of bread dough (you may not use all the water).
- 3. Knead the dough on a flat surface. Add more flour if dough is too moist; add more water if dough is too dry.
- 4. Break off a piece of dough and roll it into the size of a baseball.
- 5. Flatten the dough slightly and place a toy dinosaur (or other treasure) in the dough.
- 6. Wrap the dough back up to conceal the toy. Roll the dough in your hands to form an egg shape.
- 7. Dry dinosaur eggs using one of the following methods:
 - Let the egg air dry on wax paper for 2-3 days or until hard.
 - Bake the eggs on a cookie sheet in a 150° for about an hour.
