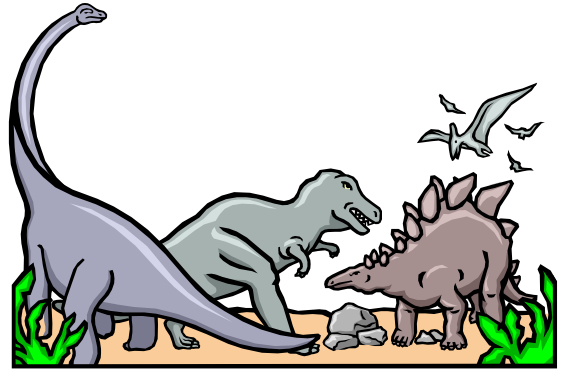


Dinosaur Eggs

This is a non-edible recipe

If your family would like to try it, you will need:

- 1 cup flour
- 1 cup used & dried coffee grounds
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup salt
- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup sand
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup water



All you need to do is:

1. Mix all dry ingredients together in a bowl.
2. Add the water in small amounts and stir the mixture until it is the consistency of bread dough (you may not use all the water).
3. Knead the dough on a flat surface. Add more flour if dough is too moist; add more water if dough is too dry.
4. Break off a piece of dough and roll it into the size of a baseball.
5. Flatten the dough slightly and place a toy dinosaur (or other treasure) in the dough.
6. Wrap the dough back up to conceal the toy. Roll the dough in your hands to form an egg shape.
7. Dry dinosaur eggs using one of the following methods:
 - Let the egg air dry on wax paper for 2-3 days or until hard.
 - Bake the eggs on a cookie sheet in a 150° for about an hour.
