

# Dough Ornaments

This is a non-edible recipe

If your family would like to try it, you will need:

2 cups flour  
2 cups salt  
1 cup water  
Christmas Cookie Cutters  
Paint  
Yarn/string



All you need to do is:

1. Mix the flour, salt and water to make the dough.
2. Knead it for about 10 minutes.
3. Roll out the dough or pat it flat with hands. Use cookie cutters to cut shapes from the dough.
4. Use a toothpick or a pencil to make a hole in the ornament.
5. Allow dough to air dry on wax paper or bake ornaments for 2-3 hours at 225° on a cookie sheet. Note: No matter what drying method you choose, flip the ornaments a few times during the process, so they dry evenly.
6. Cool completely and paint them.
7. Thread the yarn through the hole, tie off and hang it on your tree!

Variation:

"Spruce" up your ornaments by gluing objects to them (glitter, sequins, pine needles, etc.) or try decorating with nail polish!
