## Dough Ornaments

This is a non-edible recipe

If your family would like to try it, you will need:

2 cups flour
2 cups salt
1 cup water
Christmas Cookie Cutters
Paint
Yarn/string



## All you need to do is:

- 1. Mix the flour, salt and water to make the dough.
- 2. Knead it for about 10 minutes.
- 3. Roll out the dough or pat it flat with hands. Use cookie cutters to cut shapes from the dough.
- 4. Use a toothpick or a pencil to make a hole in the ornament.
- 5. Allow dough to air dry on wax paper or bake ornaments for 2-3 hours at 225° on a cookie sheet. Note: No matter what drying method you choose, flip the ornaments a few times during the process, so they dry evenly.
- 6. Cool completely and paint them.
- 7. Thread the yarn through the hole, tie off and hang it on your tree!

## Variation:

"Spruce" up your ornaments by gluing objects to them (glitter, sequins, pine needles, etc.) or try decorating with nail polish!
