Reindeer Cookies

Makes about 3 dozen cookies

If your family would like to try it, you will need:

<u>Cookie Part</u>:

- $2\frac{1}{4}$ cups flour
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1 cup margarine (softened)
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup sugar
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup packed brown sugar
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 2 eggs
- 2 cups chocolate chips

Reindeer Decorations:

- Pretzels (the mini twisted shape kind, not sticks)
- M&Ms (or other brand

All you will need to do is:

- 1. Heat oven to 375°.
- 2. Combine cookie ingredients, except chocolate chips. Stir.
- 3. Add chocolate chips and stir.
- 4. On a floured surface, roll dough into $1\frac{1}{2}$ -inch balls and place on ungreased cookie sheet about 2 inches apart.
- 5. Flatten balls slightly with bottom of a glass or with hand.
- 6. Gently press two pretzels into the dough for antlers, 2 M&Ms for eyes and one M&M for the nose (red if you want your reindeer to be like Rudolph ©).
- 7. Bake 10-13 minutes. Cool 1 minute before removing from cookie sheet.
