Very Busy Spiders



If your family would like to try it, you will need:

Body: 2 Ritz crackers (or other brand)
Legs: 4 stick pretzels - break in half for 8 legs
Eyes: 2 raisins, Craisins, M&Ms, or chocolate chips

Spread - could use peanut butter, cream cheese, cheese spread, etc). This will "glue" the spider pieces together.

All you need to do is:

- Use a butter knife (or tongue depressor) to put some spread between two crackers to form the spider's body.
- Insert the 8 pretzel "legs" between the crackers (4 on each side)
- Use more spread to attach eyes on top of the spider's body.

<u>Variations</u>:

- Try different ingredients for your spiders. What would it taste like if we used frosting for spread or sugar cookies for the body or licorice for the legs? Get creative! ©
- Serve your spiders on a web of licorice rope or cake icing.
