School Day

AM Start- Students can be dropped off at NPMLC after 7:30 am. *8:15 for students who ride the bus to St. Germain or parents drop off.



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(All students who are dropped off in St. Germain should go directly to the lunchroom)
*8:35 for students who will be dropped off and students who are riding bus from ERES.
*12:35 4K pick up (half day students) in the front of the building
*2:50 Students riding bus to ERES will depart. Parent pick in front of building.
*3:25 students who ride bus home from St. Germain are dismissed as well as parent pick up. (Back of building)

Communication

To ensure that your child has a successful school year, we will communicate through a variety of ways. Communication between of is of the utmost importance. I will be providing you with information, but please know that your feedback to me is just as important. Feel free to contact me at any time! The best way to contact me is via e-mail.

<u>Folders</u> - Each child has a folder that will go back and forth from home to school each day. The right side of the folder is labeled "Keep At Home" (these are papers that can be kept at home- please be sure to check them over) and the right side is, "Return to School" (these are papers that need your attention!) Please check the folder each evening and return any items to school in the folder. I will check the folder each morning. This has proven to be a very effective way of getting things back and forth from school and home.

<u>Remind</u> – I will not be sending paper reminders home. All reminders will be sent via Remind. If you have not already signed up for Remind, contact me for sign up information.

<u>Lunch</u>



Your child will be able to purchase hot lunch through food service or bring a lunch from home. Lunch milk is available for those students bringing lunch if desired.

MILK with Lunch: Milk is included as part of the National School Meal Program. However, ALL students will be charged \$0.45 for milk if they bring a cold breakfast and/or lunch from home. Milk is only included as part of the school meals program. Students, eligible for free/reduced meals, who bring a cold lunch from home, will also be charged \$0.45 for milk.

<u>Please check the menu that comes home each month.</u> If your child does not like a particular lunch, please send a lunch from home on that day.

**Each child will have a lunch card with their account number on it. They will be charged each time they eat hot lunch.

Your children may qualify for free meals or for reduced price meals. Reduced price is \$0.30 for breakfast and \$0.40 for lunch.

Each morning we will have a snack available for the students. Snacks are provided by Children's House families. Each month we will send home a snack calendar for the week we would like you to send in a snack.


NPMLC Birthday Celebrations
