Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are excited to offer Eagle Camp again this summer for current 4K-5th grade students in the Northland Pines School District. Eagle Camp is a summer school program that provides an educational and exciting adventure that students can participate in to stay connected with friends, keep up with academics and have fun during the middle of the summer. It is designed to keep students moving forward academically and give them a positive experience over the summer.

Eagle Camp is held at Eagle River Elementary School (ERES) and is available to all NPSD students. Eagle Camp will run for three weeks, from July 29th to August 16th. You can sign your child up for the full three weeks, two weeks or even just one week. Eagle Camp is a half day event, Monday - Friday from 8:15 AM to 12:30 PM, but you can drop your child off as early as 7:30 at ERES. **Breakfast and lunch will be provided for FREE to ALL** students that participate, but you are welcome to pack a lunch for your child if you choose. **We will be running two buses for pick up and drop off to designated locations to help parents with transportation.** One bus will begin at the Sayner Library, go to the St. Germain Elementary School and child care center, and then to ERES. This bus will follow the same route for drop off starting at 12:30. Another bus will pick up at Land O' Lakes Elementary, stop for a pickup in Conover and drop off at ERES. This bus will take the same route for drop off starting at 12:30. There is no cost for this program, you just have to be a current Northland Pines elementary student. **If you want to register your child, please complete the bottom of this form and return it to your child's school by May 1st. Late registrations will be placed on a waiting list** as we have to plan for staffing and resources. Teaching assignments will be determined later this spring based on number of registered students.

Are you looking for somewhere for your child to go in the afternoons after Eagle Camp is complete? You can contact the daycare provider of your choice to arrange for day care in the afternoons. Attached to this document is a list of their contact information.

What is the tentative schedule?

- 7:30 - 8:10 - Drop off, games and FREE breakfast in cafeteria
- 8:15 - Eagle Camp begins
- 8:15 - 9:15 - Literacy - Students will take part in reading, writing, and various literacy activities and games that are centered around each week's theme.
- 9:15 - 9:30 - Snack
- 9:30 - 10:30 - Math - Students boost math fact skills through games as well as learn math concepts through projects, centers, and/or other activities.
- 10:30 - 11:30 - Enrichment Time - Students take part in various enriching activities that focus on science or social studies projects, technology education, critical thinking skills, teamwork and more.
- 11:30 - 12:00 - Recess
- 12:00 - 12:25 - Lunch - FREE to all students but you can pack a lunch if you prefer
- 12:30 - Pick up and bus departure

Weekly Themes

Each week will have a theme in which most of the educational experiences will be centered around. The first week will be Explore The World of Science, the second week Traveling Around the World, and the third week Northwoods Adventure.
