A Fun and Motivating Program to Get Kids Reading

How Does the Program Work?

St. Germain Elementary School is partnering with the PTO, Vilas County Sheriff's Department, Plum Lake Ambulance Services, and Plum Lake Fire Department to provide a reading program that will motivate kids to read. All students have to do is keep track of their reading each month on a calendar
